

Bus Service European School II (EE2) – Mamer

Request to Support Petition

28.1.2014

Dear Parents of EE2-pupils,

With this letter, we kindly ask you to support the attached petition to the commune of Mamer. The initiative asks the commune to provide safe and efficient transportation of our children to the European School.

Currently about 250 EE2-pupils are living in Mamer (including Capellen and Holzem). Many families explicitly moved to Mamer to be close to the school. Unfortunately, they had to find out that as opposed to initial promises, there is no school bus service available for these children. In particular small children can often only be transported by car. As a consequence, the daily traffic situation around the school has become unbearable. Heavy and long-lasting congestions of the roads around the school are not only painful but also neither environmentally friendly nor in the interest of other local residents suffering from this situation.

In discussions with the Ministry of Transportation, we learned that the responsibility for the transportation of pupils relies within the individual communities. Considering that the communities around the new School are benefiting most from the location of our school, we are asking the commune of Mamer to include the European School in the transportation scheme currently provided for the pupils visiting the local school (see <http://www.mamer.lu/enseignement-et-formation/transport-scolaire/>).

We are asking for your support to emphasize the value and need of a local school bus service for EE2 with this petition.
